**Project:** The Camphill (<http://www.camphill.cz/en/index.html>) is in the centre of a small village, 5 km away from a big town. Camphill Ceske Kopisty is the first and so far only Camphill Community in the Czech Republic. Although it's been running for 10 years, it's still at the beginning of its development, therefore the volunteers will have the opportunity to get an insight into a starting project. The community already runs a day centre and a resident project for people with special needs. There are 5 residents with special needs and the family that runs Camphill living in the community, 5 more co-workers spend part of the working week there. There are also therapeutic workshops and an organic vegetable farm, products of which are sold to organic shops.

**Work:** The volunteers will perform two different kinds of manual work. Firstly they will be helping on the organic farm (mainly on the fields). Secondly they will be helping with cleaning and maintaining the areal of the community and assisting in reconstructing different buildings of the center. Occasionally they may be joined by the residents with special needs, who live and work in the community. The work is mainly manual.

**Study part:** Camphill is run on a community basis, with its own ideologies and people with special needs are integrated in its life and work. Possibility to learn about the Camphill movement all over the world, life in a community and organic farming. Visit to the nearby Terezin Memorial at the sight of the former concentration camp for Jews – the Terezin Ghetto.

**Accommodation/Food:** The volunteers will sleep in a big hall on mattresses. One shower in the residential house with hot water will be available. The volunteers will prepare their meals on their own. Bring your local recipes!

**Location:** České Kopisty (near Litoměřice - <http://www.litomerice.cz/eng/> and Terezin - <http://www.terezin.cz/en/index.asp>), 70 km away from Prague. Nearby there's mountains [www.ceskestredohori.cz](http://www.ceskestredohori.cz)

**Extras:** Consumption of alcohol and usage of drugs are strictly forbidden within the community. Smoking is allowed out of the community area. Bring your own sleeping bag, working boots and warm clothes, for the nights can be quite cool.

**Project:** Rock for People is the biggest Czech outdoor festival whose history goes back to 1994. These days it is an event organized at a beautiful site of Festival Park in Hradec Kralove at the beginning of July. The dates for 2011 are 2nd-5th July. There are 30.000 punters every year from Czech Republic as well as abroad. The festival consists of 5 musical stages, previous headliners include such names as Muse, Prodigy, Kaiser Chiefs, The Offspring, Morcheeba, and many more. Our partner, Capricorn Promotion, is the one responsible for the ecological side of it.

**Work:**

The work will consist of various duties on festival's cleaning and recycling program. The festival maintains very advanced waste management system which includes its own on-site separating plant, numerous green-points throughout the festival area, and requires help by many volunteers who pick litter throughout the site, help with green points management, drive on site and carry litter to the separating plant, and work on recycling plant.

**Accommodation:** In tents at the festival backstage. Bring your own tent :)

**Study part:** Volunteers will have an excellent opportunity to look behind the scenes of a large outdoor music festival.

**Others:** Own tent and sleeping bag, not accessible for wheelchairs.
